 IN CONJUNCTION WITH COMMUNITY BASED VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND HAVE

THE GOLD STAR MENTORING PROGRAM AWARD IS AWARDED BY ILLINOIS MENTORING PARTNERSHIP (IMP) TO ILLINOIS-BASED MENTORING PROGRAMS THAT MEET OR EXCEED BEST PRACTICES ACROSS SIX ESSENTIAL PROGRAM AREAS, AS ESTABLISHED BY MENTOR: THE NATIONAL MENTORING PARTNERSHIP. IMP RECOGNIZES PROGRAMS ANNUALLY THAT OFFER THE BEST OUTCOMES FOR MENTORS AND MENTEES.






CHAMPS FINANCIALS THREE YEAR FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE

2019 REVENUE \$ 50,000.00




2020 REVENUE \$ 291,560.00






