MISSION:



 The mission of the C.H.A.M.P.S. Male Mentoring Program is to Educate, Empower and Expose Boys and Young Men of Color beyond the four walls of the school in order to help them to achieve their dreams and goals.



PROGRAM GOALS

SCHOOL BASED-COMMUNICATION
OUR GOAL is to have 80% of CHAMPS mentees score proficient in communicating effectively and persuasively their vision, goals, and plans to accomplish them based on CHAMPS created rubrics.
How would it be measured?

- Using CHAMPS created rubrics with a scale ranging from Level 1 to Level 4. The rubric identifies content and structure for the mentees to clearly articulate their thoughts. (Refer to rubric 1)
- 2. Mentors will use the rubric to fairly evaluate each mentee and formulate a score based on the rubric. Each level is worth 1 point. Each level is labeled as such:
- · Level One: "Need Improvement"
- · Level Two: "Fair"
- · Level Three: "Proficient"
- · Level Four: "Exemplar"

COMMUNITY- BASED-EXPOSURE

OUR GOAL is to have 80% of CHAMPS mentees will obtain their U.S. Passport so we can expose our young men to experiences that would increase their perspective of self and the world.

- 1. Champs will pay 100% of the Passport Fee
- Champs will help secure their ID, SS Card, and Birth Certificate or other important documents
- 3. Champs will pay for travel for mentees selected

GOLD-STAR AWARD PROGRAM

STAT: YOUTH WHO MEET REGULARLY WITH THEIR MENTORS ARE 46% LESS LIKELY THAN THEIR PEERS TO START USING ILLEGAL DRUGS AND 27% LESS LIKELY TO START DRINKING. INVESTMENT IN MENTORSHIP HAVE BENEFITS THAT LIFE ALTERING.

CHAMPS PROVEN MODEL

- WE HAVE BEEN TEACHING THE SEL CLASS FOR SEVERAL YEARS AND HAVE DEVELOPED A CULTURALLY RELEVANT CURRICULUM THAT IS ALIGNED TO THE STATE SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING STANDARDS.
- WE HAVE A PROVEN MODEL TO WORK FROM THAT IS ALREADY BEING USED AND REPLICATED IN 4 OTHER CITIES AND A DOZEN MORE SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES.
- WE ARE RECEIVING SUPPORT FROM THE CITY OF CHICAGO, AND THE STATE OF ILLINOIS
 IN CONJUNCTION WITH COMMUNITY BASED VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND HAVE
 PARTNERED WITH UP-METRICS TO EXTENSIVELY TRACK AND MEASURE IMPACT.
- IT IS ALSO IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT C.H.A.M.P.S. RECEIVED THE GOLD STAR MENTORING PROGRAM AWARD FROM THE ILLINOIS MENTORING PARTNERSHIP IN 2018. THE GOLD STAR MENTORING PROGRAM AWARD IS AWARDED BY ILLINOIS MENTORING PARTNERSHIP (IMP) TO ILLINOIS-BASED MENTORING PROGRAMS THAT MEET OR EXCEED BEST PRACTICES ACROSS SIX ESSENTIAL PROGRAM AREAS, AS ESTABLISHED BY MENTOR: THE NATIONAL MENTORING PARTNERSHIP. IMP RECOGNIZES PROGRAMS ANNUALLY THAT OFFER THE BEST OUTCOMES FOR MENTORS AND MENTEES.







2019 REVENUE \$ 50,000






